After Breakfast - gather in the Lounge/Lobby area to start our adventure - Today we will explore the Sites and Stories of Lewis and Clark and their Adventures with visit to: Fort Clatsop for activities and stories from the Lewis & Clark Journals. Return to the Astoria Fairgrounds for more Demonstrations of life during the Lewis and Clark Times.

Lunch is on your own -- Gather for an afternoon in the Columbia River Maritime Museum (1hr Guided Tour, Choice of 3D Movie about the Hurricane's or The Aircraft Carrier's -- Explore the Museum or visit the boat on the River and additional activities in the area -- Visit to the Astoria Column, a visit to the Bumble Bee Cannery Museum - Walk a mile to follow in the footsteps of Meriwether Lewis, William Clark and the rest of the courageous team who, led by Sacagawea, as they explored what is now present-day Oregon and Washington.

Return to the Hotel after a full day of exploring - Dinner is on your own (we will have suggestions) and options -- Enjoy a soak in the Indoor Pool, or warm Hot Tub/Sauna - before you retire.

October 9, 2018 - Tuesday Today after breakfast at the Hotel or Continental Breakfast on Boat and Plated Lunch - we will gather to transfer to the Portland Spirit at the dock at Columbia River Maritime Museum (1792 Marine Dr. Astoria - Boarding Begins at 8:30am - so will depart the Hotel at 7:45am -- Speakers will begin at 9:15am with the cruise departing the dock at 11:00am -

October 10, 2018- Wednesday After our **Hot Breakfast** is another cool day to explore the area.

We may also follow what a reporter for THE OREGONIAN in 1880 described as "perhaps the most wicked place on earth for its population". The Heritage Museum has chosen the more inflammatory portion of this title - where half of the fish canneries of the lower Columbia River were located in Astoria.. The Today we will enjoy Astoria for some shopping/ exploring and/or relaxing at the Hotel -

About Noon we will board the Astoria Trolley or our Van to Seaside for the afternoon – Lunch in Seaside on your own (Suggestions will be provided). This afternoon is your time to enjoy Seaside -

Choose your adventure - Bike riding along the Beach Path, Visit the Aquarium in Seaside, Fly your Kite on the Beaches, Have a round of Golf, visit the Arcadia Beach State Recreation Area - for some breathtaking views of the ocean and the surrounding landscape or stroll along the Seaside Promenade for some shopping - Check out the Ecola State Park, a sandy coastal beach park also known as the Indian Beach - A perfect setting for hiking a bit and to escape the adventurous backpacker. Finally if you wish spend some time at the Lewis and Clark National Wildlife Refuge (a Vast 30,000 acre wildlife refuge features many attractions - such as a 20 island stretch that is only accessible by boat along with a habitat consisting of tidal sands and forested swamps. Have **Farewell Dinner** on The 11th with time for other activities in the Astoria area – (to be advised) - Return to the Hotel to get ready to return to Portland then next morning.
